

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
PERRY TOWNSHIP
December 1, 2020

The committee-of -the- whole meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman Lance N. Adam at 7:30 p.m. on December 1, 2020 from the Perry Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA. The meeting was also being held via zoom conferencing to allow residents to attend due to limited social distancing seating in the meeting room. The format for tonight's meeting is in compliance with PSATS. The meeting is being recorded.

Roll call was held and the following Supervisors were present:

The Supervisors went into an Executive Session.

Comments: Dennis Huey questioned the Peterbuilt repair. Chairman Adam said he will discuss later in meeting.

Bills: Preliminary list of Invoices was looked over.

Minutes: The Unofficial meeting minutes from November 2, 2020 and November 10, 2020 minutes were looked over.

Preliminary 2021 Budget- Motion was made by Supervisor Daly to advertise the 2021 Preliminary Budget, seconded by Chairman Adam. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

2021 Municipal Tax Sheet- Chairman Adam said this is the same mileage as every other year. Supervisor Daly questioned the light tax, Supervisor Adam stated its for the street lights. Motion was made by Chairman Adam to keep the same mileage rates and light tax for 2021, seconded by Supervisor Daly. Motion caried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Code Red- This is an emergency alert for all the residents of Perry Township. It will send an alert that is tied into the 911 system. Shoey Borough already has this in place. Perry Township fee is \$1500 thanks to Jarrod Emes. He got them to match the price that Shoey is paying. Motion was made by Supervisor Adam to pay for Code Red system with an annual fee of \$1500 for the unlimited use of the Code Red system, so that it can be up and running by January 1, 2021. Motion was seconded by Supervisor Daly. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Toys for Tots- There is a Toys for Tots box in the lobby. Unwrapped toys may be deposited in the lobby.

Chairman Adam presented applications for part time CDL drivers for the winter. Dustin Wagner and Dennis Wagner (Rusty the fire chief). Supervisor Adam asked if they were going to have to take drug tests and background test. Chairman Adam stated yes, they will, whatever is in the Handbook. Motion was made by Chairman Adam to hire Dustin Wagner as a part time winter CDL driver, seconded by Supervisor Daly. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Chairman Adam made the motion to hire Dennis Wagner as a part time CDL driver for the winter, seconded by Supervisor Daly. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Chairman Adam made the motion to hire Mason Moyer as a part time winter employee pending the testing is met, seconded by Supervisor Daly. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Chairman Adam stated that the Peterbuilt went out for estimates from Nolt's, Levan, Dissinger, E.M. Kutz. Dissinger would not patch and Premier Fleet would not touch it either. Levan said they will do it for \$1025.00 to do a temporary patch job to get us thru the winter and we will have it back by Friday. Levan is willing to put their name on the repair. Chairman Adam will take truck to Levan tonight after meeting and it will be finished on Friday. This is an emergency repair and needs to be done.

There were 24 more tires dumped. 15 on one pile and 9 on the other. Hey are far enough in the woods, and out of the right away. Chairman Adam will call the plant manager at Glen Gery tomorrow. Supervisor Daly made a motion to purchase 2-3 Trail Cams not to exceed the price of \$500. Motion was seconded by Chairman Adam. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.
