PERRY TOWNSHIP
April 14, 2020

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman Lance N. Adam at 7:30 p.m. on April 14, 2020 from the Perry Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA via telephonic conferencing due to Covid-19 social distancing requirements. The format for tonight's meeting is in compliance with PSATS.

Chairman Adam stated only comments regarding agenda items will be addressed. No comments were given.

Approval of Minutes:

Dean A. Adam made a motion, seconded by Patrick Daly to approve the March 3rd Committee Meeting and the March 10th Supervisors Meeting minutes. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

False Fire Alarm Ordinance

Allen Shollenberger, Solicitor, stated the False Fire Alarm Ordinance has been duly advertised and is ready to adopt if the Board so chooses. The Board will need to finalize a policy for the internal reporting and recording of documented incidents. This policy has no impact on the Ordinance. Lance N. Adam made a motion, seconded by Dean A. Adam to adopt the False Fire Alarm Ordinance 04-20. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

EMC Position:

Chairman Adam stated the Board has received one application for the position of EMC Coordinator. The Board has reviewed his resume and with the current pandemic Chairman Adam feels it's in the best interest of the Township to appoint him. Patrick Daly stated the resume is very impressive. Dean Adam stated he has never met him and wouldn't want to hire someone without first meeting with them. Mr. Shollenberger suggested hiring on an interim basis. Mr. Daly asked if the position was compensable. Chairman Adam stated Shoemakersville Borough pays the EMC coordinator. Lance N. Adam made a motion, seconded by Patrick Daly to hire Jarrod Emes as the Perry Township EMC Coordinator on an interim basis of thirty (30) days with a monthly compensation of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Letter of Support:

Chairman Adam stated the Township received a request from the Borough of Shoemakersville for a letter of support for improvements to the Shoemakersville Park. They are applying for a grant to help with drainage issues on the playground. All Supervisors are in support of Rosanne sending a letter of support for their project.

Comments:

Nancy James, Ridge Road, stated this is the first time she has done something like this and said it is quite interesting. Mrs. James asked for clarification about the EMC position. She asked why the Township has waited two or three months to make a decision. Mrs. James said if two Supervisors are in favor of hiring him, she feels it's inappropriate to wait. Chairman Adam stated we did hire him on an interim basis to give Dean Adam an opportunity to meet with him.

Chairman Adam stated any other comments should be emailed to the township and Rosanne will forward them to me.
