

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
PERRY TOWNSHIP  
March 5, 2019

The committee-of-the-whole meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman Dean A. Adam, at 7:30 p.m. on March 5, 2019 in the Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA.

A roll call was held and the following Supervisors were present:

**Comments:**

Chairman Adam asked for public comments.

Dave Lindenmuth, Recreation Board Chairman, stated at last month's Rec. Board meeting it was discussed to replace the rotting boards outside the bathrooms. Dave would like approval from the Board to pay for the materials and he would make the repairs. He would be using pressure treated wood at an estimated cost of \$247.77. Lance N. Adam, Vice Chairman suggested putting a cap on the cost of the repairs. Lance N. Adam made a motion seconded by Mark Wm Stitzel to approve repairs for the wood at the bathrooms in the Recreation Park for no more than \$350.00. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Nancy James, Ridge Road, spoke about Senator Argall's office suggesting she submits typed documentation of the topics she speaks about at meeting for the board. She questioned where the procedures to get on the agenda came from the solicitor or township. The Board suggested looking at PSATS. Mark Wm. Stitzel noted that no letter was given to the township from Senator Argall's office regarding accepting submissions of letters for the board. Mrs. James stated this was how their meeting was run and they suggested by phone she could do the same for Perry Township Meetings. Mrs. James filled out a right to know request wanting a copy of the letter from last months meeting regarding the information with 69 news. Dean A. Adam stated she can have a copy when a right to know request is filled out. Nancy James stated it has to do with the request she already filled out. Secretary Seidel stated that a new right to know request will need to be submitted since the document was created after the first request and was a memo to the board to make them aware of the situation.

Dennis Huey, Recreation Board Member, stated the lights around the flag pole were not working near the rock. Lance N. Adam stated he tried to reach them but they were hard to get too. Dean A. Adam stated wait until it is warmer to fix the lights due to the mud around the pole.
