The committee-of-the-whole meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman Lance N. Adam, at 7:30 p.m. on October 5, 2021 in the Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA. This meeting is being recorded. This meeting is available on ZOOM.

**Public Comments:**

**Nancy James-** On Zoom- Nancy emailed the Scout Master for help with the flowerbed at the township building. She would like help with moving the stones, raking mulch, etc. to make it look nice for election day next month. Chairman Adam and Supervisor Daly thanked Nancy for all the flowers she planted at the recreation park.

**Daniel Moyer- 467 Mohrsville Rd-** Dan spoke with Joe Body about a permit to put his steps back up for a fire escape. Joe instructed him that he would need a letter of approval from the Municipal Authority since they were involved with removing the steps. Chairman Adam advised Dan to attend the MA meeting on Oct 13, 2021 at 6:30 pm.

**Dennis Huey-** Dennis requested getting an estimate for tree trimming at the recreation park. Chairman Adam said yes.

4. **Review List of Invoices-** No comments on Preliminary Bills for Payment.

5. **Review Unofficial Minutes** of Committee Meeting of September 7, 2021, and the Supervisor's Meeting of September 14, 2021. No comments on the minutes.

6. **Trick-or-Treat Nights-** Shoemakersville Borough Trick-or-Treat nights are Thursday Oct 28 and Friday Oct 29 from 6-9 pm. To make things easier on the families, Perry Township will follow Shoemakersville Borough. Chairman Adam made a motion to set 2021 Perry Township Trick-or-Treat nights for Thursday Oct 28 and Friday Oct 29 from 6-9 pm. Supervisor Daly seconded the motion. Motion carried with all supervisors present voting yes.

7. **Donation to Crime Alert Berks County-** Last year the donation allotment was set at the re-organization meeting. Supervisor Daly recommended speaking with Sandy Madara about the donation. She is a member of the Crime Alert Berks County Board. Last year Perry Township donated \$2,500.00. The township will reach out to Sandy for an appropriate donation amount for this year. Deane Hamm requested more Crime Alert signs.

8. **Lions Club Pumpkin Hunt-** The Lions Club would like to do their 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Kids Pumpkin Hunt on Saturday October 23, 2021 at 7:00 pm at the Perry Recreation Park. Supervisor Daly made a motion to approve the use of the Perry Recreation Park for the Lions Club 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Pumpkin Hunt on October 23, rain-date October 24, 2021. Chairman Adam seconded the motion. Motion carried with all supervisors present voting yes.

9. **Recreation Park Deposits-** Currently the recreation park deposits do not go into the Recreation Park Fund. The Recreation Park Fund does not have a steady income of money. Chairman Adam made a motion for all recreation park deposits to be deposited into the Recreation Park Fund. Supervisor Daly seconded the motion. Motion carried with all supervisors present voting yes.

10. **Snow Plow Upgrade-** The snow plow currently on the old Peterbilt is not heavy enough and does not have an ejection shoot to handle heavy snow. Chairman Adam would like to upgrade the snow plow on the old Peterbilt to match the snow plow on the new Peterbilt. Dennis Huey and Deane Hamm agreed. Chairman Adam made a motion to order a new snow plow from E.M. Kutz for the amount of \$17,849.00, and keep the old plow as an emergency back-up. The trade-in value of the old plow is \$2,071.00. Supervisor Daly seconded the motion. Motion carried with all supervisors present voting yes.

**Public Comments:**

**Deane Hamm-** Dean suggested listing the old plow on Municibid. If the township doesn't get a worthwhile bidding price, then they can still keep the plow. Chairman Adam interjected that the new plow wouldn't be here for 90-120 days, so we would still need the old plow for part of this winter. Chairman Adam said they will revisit the old plow situation at a later date.

Chairman Adam made a motion, seconded by Supervisor Daly. to adjourn the meeting at 7:42 p.m. Motion carried with all Supervisors present voting yes.
