Crime Alerts Berks County Donation- A donation request was received from Crime Alerts Berks County. Perry Township donates every year. Chairman Adam made a motion to donate \$500.00 to Crime Alerts Berks County. Supervisor Harron seconded the motion. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.

Highs traffic signal maintenance proposal for October 1- December 31, 2024 in the amount of \$200.00. Chairman Adam seconded the motion. Motion carried with all Supervisors voting yes.
