The Recreation Board Meeting of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman David Lindenmuth, at 7:00 p.m. on April 26, 2022 in the Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA.

3. **Meeting Minutes from Recreation Board March 29, 2022-** Installation of the new playground equipment was discussed. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to approve the minutes from March 29, 2022. Mike Dreibelbis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

4. **Treasurer's Report:** As of March 31, 2022, the current balance in the Recreation Fund is \$14,045.03.

5. **Playground Equipment Update-** The new playground equipment is ready to be picked up. New edgers will potentially need to be purchased. There are currently 28 edgers leftover in the park shed. Mike is going to handle ordering mulch. Keystone Landscaping charges the same amount whether the mulch is delivered by them or hauled by the township.

6. **Park Rental Contract-** The park rental contract was revised. Changes include increased rental fee with correlation to amount of guests, added security deposit, baseball field availability, and a clearer liability agreement. Chairman Lindenmuth questioned shared use with the public. The park has always been open to the public regardless of rental status, the pavilion is the only 100% reserved space. Chairman Lindenmuth mentioned the idea of being available after dusk. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to approve the revised park rental contract. Mike Dreibelbis seconded the motion. Motion carried. The contract will go before the Supervisor Board for final approval.

7. **Park Upgrades-** Joseph Dalton gave an update on some upgrades happening at the park. The flower bed has been revived and mulched. 5 or 6 blue bird houses will be installed, following the driveway to the pond area, along with a few in the open pond area. Materials for the blue bird house will be donated. Some gardening equipment will be kept in the shed between the bathrooms for easy access. Mike suggested another area of the park (below the Dietrich Field) for a future flowerbed.

8. **Bathroom Renovation-** The new paper towel dispensers and soap dispensers arrived. The water heater arrived. The township crew will be painting the inside and outside of the bathroom. Rusty Wagner is waiting on stale divider prices for the women's room.

**New Business:** Longhorn Landscaping trimmed trees at the recreation park.

-Potentially looking at expanding the concession stand with an attached concrete patio and pavilion. Patrick Daly joined the meeting on speaker-phone. Chairman Lindenmuth was concerned if a fire suppression system would have to be installed. Pat informed a sprinkler system would be required if there is open flame cooking inside the concession stand. The 2<sup>nd</sup> disbursement of ARPA could potentially be used. Responsible parties for stocking and maintenance were discussed. The electric and water both run underground towards the Bell Field, and will not be an issue with expansion.

-The potential of adding a frisbee golf course by the pond was discussed.

-Hilltop will fix the bare spots their hydroseeding didn't cover on the Bell outfield.

**Adjourn:** Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion, seconded by Mike Dreibelbis to adjourn the meeting at 8:00 p.m. Motion carried.
