The Recreation Board Meeting of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman David Lindenmuth, at 7:00 p.m. on February 22, 2022 in the Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA.

3. **Meeting Minutes from Recreation Board January 25, 2022-** Mike Dreibelbis made a motion to approve the minutes from January 25, 2022. Chairman Lindenmuth seconded the motion. Motion carried.

4. **Playground Equipment-** The Board of Supervisors allocated \$30,000.00 of the ARPA funds towards the new playground. The area available for the new playground equipment is 50ft x 70ft. This covers the doom, slide, and see-saws, which will all be removed and sold. The selected new equipment will easily fit into this space. The number of plastic barriers for the mulch will need to be looked at. Shipping is around \$3,400.00; a shipping vs pick-up price comparison will be done. Concrete will be needed to anchor the poles. The playground will also be re-mulched.

5. **Bathroom Renovation-** An estimate was obtained from RD Contracting for \$2,600.00. This does not include stall dividers, painting the walls, and sealing the floor. Currently stall dividers are back ordered 12-15 weeks. Discussed making the men's bathroom a single use bathroom, depending on stall divider availability and price. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to approve the estimate from RD Contracting at \$2,600.00. Mike Dreibelbis seconded the motion. Motion carried. A separate estimate will be obtained for paint, floors, and stall dividers.

6. **Capping Dug-Outs-** RD Contracting is donating their time and materials to capping the dug-outs. Any parts not capped will be painted.

7. **Concession Stand Speakers-** Billman Electric will be contacted to supply an estimate for adding a speaker to the concession stand for playing the National Anthem.

New Business: The existing batting cage will be coming down in March. Jesse Adam is removing the batting cage and disposing of it as donation. NFI is paying for everything with the new batting cage. Portable toilet will be there in mid-March. Baseball field clean-up is in March. Adding a cement pad in front of the concession stand is on the potential future project list.

Adjourn: Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion, seconded by Mike Dreibelbis to adjourn the meeting at 7:30 p.m. Motion carried.
