David Lindenmuth made a motion to purchase 2- 52" Lifetime, Polycarb shatter proof basketball backboards from Walmart at a price to not exceed \$550.00. Mike Dreibelbis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

- Top-soiled and seeded the bank at playground equipment
- Vent holes cut in the bathrooms
- Eagle Scout project- refinishing and painting the pavilion and concession stand benches and tables.
- All lightbulbs changed to LED

Other Business:

- Multiple areas need to be top-soiled and seeded (after Boy Scout car show)
- Replace pipe at the Eagle Scout bridge
- Discussed the swale and potential pipe locations at the lower parking lot
- Discussed hosting more family events at the park
- Perry Elementary donated to the Rec Fund again.
- UV light system for the concession stand
- Hamburg soccer interested in using the park for practice. Will confirm and create contract.
- Discussed the need for trash enclosures at the baseball fields and concession stand.
- Expansion of lower parking lot
- Crack seal parking lot
- Removal of 3 trees between Dietrich and Bell field (fall/winter)
