The Recreation Board Meeting of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman David Lindenmuth, at 7:00 p.m. on March 29, 2022 in the Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA.

3. **Meeting Minutes from Recreation Board February 22, 2022-** Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to approve the minutes from February 22, 2022. Mike Dreibelbis seconded the motion. Motion carried.

4. **Playground Equipment Update-** Discussed removal, transportation, and temporary storage of the old equipment. Township will use the backhoe and rent a mini excavator from Kuzans to prep the area for new equipment. To minimize damage, Mike suggested a hammer attachment for the mini excavator to release the old equipment from the existing concrete. Looking into hiring a surveyor to help with the installation of the new equipment; Rochelle will call Joe Body. An installation guide will be requested from the manufacturer. Patrick Daly and Lance Adam are picking up the new equipment using rental vehicles. New edgers and mulch will be quoted. Keystone Landscape was used prior for playground mulch- looking at 2 loads. Measurements need to be taken of the old equipment after removal.

5. **Bathroom Renovation Update-** Touch-less paper towel dispensers and soap dispensers were selected and ordered for a total of \$182.58. The bathroom locks will all be changed out to match and code compliant levers will be installed. Lance Adam agreed the township will paint the inside and outside of the bathrooms, along with poxy coating the floors. The divider will be removed from the men's room to make it a single use bathroom.

6. **Concession Stand Speakers-** Outdoor Bose speakers were generously donated. They will be mounted at the concession stand with a stereo inside.

New Business: A plastic paper holder for rental signs will be purchased and hung at the pavilion.

- The wooden fence needs to be resealed.
- The inside of the concession stand needs to be repainted.
- The Pepsi cooler in the concession stand is not in the best working condition. Repair of the cooler will be looked into. The Baseball Association also contacted PepsiCo for possible donation of a new cooler.
- Billy Blankenbiller gave a verbal estimate of \$785.00 to trim the trees up to 12-14ft at the rec park, an official estimate will be sent.
- The rental contract will be revised. Revisions will include rental fees, baseball field availability, credit card payments, and security deposits. Renters will be held more accountable for damage to township property.
- The new batting cage will be complete in about 2 months. Fully funded by NFI.
- Concrete area in front of the concession stand will be revisited in the fall.

Adjourn: Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion, seconded by Mike Dreibelbis to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m. Motion carried.
