The Recreation Board Meeting of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman David Lindenmuth, at 7:00 p.m. on May 31, 2022 at the Perry Recreation Park, 730 Onyx Cave Road, Hamburg, PA.

3. **Meeting Minutes from Recreation Board April 26, 2022-** New edgers do not need to be purchased for the playground equipment installation. The water heater was not installed in the bathroom yet, and stall divider quote has not been obtained. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to approve the minutes from April 26, 2022. Mike Dreibelbis seconded the motion. Motion carried.
4. **Treasurer's Report:** As of April 30, 2022, the current balance in the Recreation Fund is \$14,790.39. Invoices for the weed spraying and electrical upgrades in the concession stand have been paid from the Recreation Fund in May.
5. **Letter of Interest-** A letter of interest was received by Robert Schaner to fill the vacant position on the Recreation Board. Rochelle Dreibelbis made a motion to accept the letter of interest from Robert Schaner for the Recreation Board, seconded by Mike Dreibelbis. Motion carried.
6. **Playground Equipment Installation-** The new equipment will be installed at the end of June, after the baseball season is over. The area will be remeasured for the possibility of keeping the climbing dome. The township laborers and volunteers will do the installation. A mini excavator and auger will be rented from Kuzans.
7. **Concession Pavilion-** Discussion of expanding the existing concession stand, along with an attached pavilion was held. The area available for expansion is roughly 60ft x 40ft. One tree in that area would have to be removed to prevent concrete disturbance. Electric appliances (griddle, fryers, etc) would not require a sprinkler system due to no open flame. This will be confirmed with Kraft. A new cooler will need to be purchased. Obtaining an architectural drawing will be the next step.
8. **Bell Field Dugouts-** The Perry Baseball Association would like to add dugouts to the Bell Field. As a resident, Pat Daly fully supports the addition. No objections from the Recreation Board. The plan will be run by the Supervisor's Board.

New Business:

- Ryan Daly presented his Eagle Scout Project for the Perry Recreation Park. The project would be updating the worn-down gravel walk-way, from the parking lot to the concession stand, to concrete. The Recreation Board gave their full support. The project is also a legacy project. Ryan will also present his project to the Supervisors Board.
- The spraying of the in-fields is causing an issue with the out-field grass dying. All Green looked at the issue. They will cover all costs to re-seed the outfield, and will contact the manufacturer of the product. Discussion was had on where to spray for the 2nd application in July.
- The bathrooms and hand rails have been painted. New soap dispensers and paper towels dispensers are going up. New trash cans in place. A baby-changing station will be hung in the handicap bathroom. Waiting on stall divider in women's room before the floors can be poxy-coated. The outside will also be painted.

- Perry Elementary raised \$120.00 for the Recreation Park. A thank you card will be sent.
- The basketball polls and pavilion polls will be painted.
- The picnic tables are in the process of being raised.
- New bleachers will be looked into for the Bell Field. Mike suggested concrete under the bleachers.
- The main parking lot needs to be paved.

Adjourn: Mike Dreibelbis made a motion, seconded by Chairman Lindenmuth to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m. Motion carried.
