The Recreation Board Meeting of Perry Township was called to order by Chairman David Lindenmuth, at 7:30 p.m. on October 26, 2021 in the Township Municipal Building, 680 Moselem Springs Road, Shoemakersville, PA.

3. Meeting Minutes from Recreation Board September 28, 2021- Correction was made by Lance Adam on amount of top soil loads donated and hauled. Schlouch donated 7 loads and Allen Schaeffer donated 2 loads. All loads were loaded and hauled by Perry Township. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to approve the minutes from September 28, 2021 with the correction from Lance Adam. Mike Dreibelbis seconded the motion. Motion carried. Meeting minutes from the previous secretary have not been forwarded.

4. New Flag Pole- The recreation board received quotes from American Flag Shop for a flag pole with installation between the baseball fields. The cost of the flag-pole will be added to the donation request to NFI. Quotes were given on a 25ft, 30ft and 35ft flag pole with installation. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to approve the quote for a 30ft flag pole with installation at \$6,900.00 to be added to the donation packet for NFI.

5. Spraying Recreation Park – Currently there is one quote from The Weedman, which did not entail what was asked of and their spray will not kill weeds on the in-fields. Mike is meeting a gentleman from All Green Lawn and Tree Services Wednesday at 5:30pm for another quote. A call was made to Ehrlich as well, no response yet.

6. Bathroom renovation- Scope of work to be done: poly stall dividers, paint, fans and lights, vent holes, battery operated soap and towel dispensers, poxy coat floors, and add hot water heater. Quotes will be requested from the Wagner brothers, Chris Forte, and Ontelaunee Builders.

7. Cell-Tower Money- The recreation park fund does not have a consistent monetary income. A discussion/vote will be put onto the Committee Meeting Agenda in regards to a portion of the recreation park cell tower money going into the recreation fund. Lance Adam also recommended a max amount being set by the Supervisors Board in which the Recreation Board does not need their approval to spend.

8. Motion sensing lights- Spotlights on the corner of the concession stand are not working. The recreation board is looking to add more lights to the park. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to add a taller LED dusk/dawn light on the corner of the concession stand and a spotlight on the back of the bathhouse. Motion was seconded by Mike Dreibelbis. Motion carried.

9. “Christmas in the Park” donation- “Christmas in the Park” will be December 18, 2021 at Shoemakersville Park. This is a joint event with the Lions Club, Shoemakersville Borough, and Perry Township. Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion to donate \$1,000.00 towards “Christmas in the Park” from the Recreation Park Fund. Motion seconded by Mike Dreibelbis. Motion carried.

New Business: Mike and Lance had discussed moving the batting cage back further. NFI is still looking to donate to the community, Mike is putting together a packet with upgrades for the park to present to them. The packet will include a double electronic scoreboard, flag pole, electric for lights and scoreboard, and possibly a new batting cage. The gutters need to be cleaned out at the pavilion. The Recreation Board approved to look

into a leaf blower awhile ago. The Recreation Board and the Perry Baseball Association are going to split the cost of a nice leaf blower. Chairman Lindenmuth will inquire about a donation or discount towards a back-pack leaf blower. Billy Blankenbiller is going to give a quote for tree trimming at the park.

Adjourn: Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion, seconded by Mike Dreibelbis to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. Motion carried.
