Comments:

Lance Adam- NFI, whom oversees Kimberly Clark warehouse, is interested in giving back to the community. Lance will get contacts for Mike in regards to donations towards the recreation park/ baseball association, including an electronic scoreboard. October 23, 2021, the Lions Club will be hosting a pumpkin hunt at the recreation park. Lance will address the Board of Supervisors regarding the after-hours pumpkin hunt.

3. Meeting Minutes from Recreation Board May 25, 2021- minutes were not able to be approved due to the previous secretary's resignation. No minutes were forwarded for review.

4. **Outfield Remediation-** Hilltop is going to remediate the Bell Field outfield. Plan is for a 2-inch cap and hydroseed. Schlouch Excavating is donating 10 loads of top soil. Schlouch will load the trucks and the township will haul. Lance is going to find a driver to haul the topsoil. Perry Township approved payment of \$3,200.00 to Hilltop for the project.

5. **Spraying Baseball Fields/ Future Spray Schedule-** Mike proposed a maintenance/ spraying schedule for the recreation park. Time frame would be after baseball season (July- November). The best route would be to contract the work out, no liability on the township. Lance agreed. The park needs to be kept looking nice for rentals.

6. **New Batting Cage-** Plan is to model after Shoey Baseball's: blacktop, metal poles, same location and size. There is a Perry Baseball Association meeting on Sunday (Oct 2, 2021). Batting cage will be discussed there. Re-visit next Recreation Board meeting.

7. **Donation from Lions Club for bathroom updates-** Lions Club donated \$1,000.00 to the recreation park towards bathroom updates. Dave looking into new vents, fans, interior paint, and partitions.

New Business: potential dog park area, new basketball poles, installing a flag pole

Adjourn: Chairman Lindenmuth made a motion, seconded by Mike Dreibelbis to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 p.m. Motion carried.
